



Purpose: The purpose of consent to treat is to ensure that patients can make informed, voluntary decisions about their care.

CONSENT TO TREAT

In addition to evaluation and management, I consent to authorize Dr Spears to perform, if medically necessary, in-office MUSCULOSKELETAL DIAGNOSTIC ULTRASOUND, ELECTRODIAGNOSTIC TESTING - INCLUDING ELECTROMYOGRAPHY (EMG) AND/OR NERVE CONDUCTION STUDIES (NCS), AND OSTEOPATHIC MANIPULATION.

There will be a separate procedure consent form for the following procedures: dry needling, ultrasound guided nerve blocks, ultrasound guided joint injections, non-ultrasound guided joint injections, other musculoskeletal injection procedure, chemodenervation with botulinum toxins (Botox, Xeomin, Dysport, and/or Myobloc). DRY NEEDLING, NON-SPINAL INTERVENTIONAL PAIN MANAGEMENT INJECTIONS INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO: ULTRASOUND GUIDED NERVE BLOCKS, ULTRASOUND GUIDED JOINT INJECTIONS, and NON-ULTRASOUND GUIDED JOINT INJECTIONS: A separate procedural fee will be submitted to your insurance carrier for these procedures. You will be obligated to pay any deductible and/or co-payments that are applied to this claim. Although it is rare for these procedures to be denied by an insurance plan, each plan varies in its reimbursement policies and procedures.

Medical Care Request and Authorization: I understand that I may have a condition that requires medical care. I am requesting and authorizing medical care by Spears Pain & Rehab and any of the physicians, physician assistants, and/or nurse practitioners associated with Spears Pain & Rehab.

Health or the facility at which the medical care is rendered whom Spears Pain & Rehab considers reasonably necessary for my care: I recognize that I may, at any time, be a participant in and make decisions regarding my health care, including the right to accept or refuse medical or procedural treatment, the right to formulate advance directives, and to provide any such directive for my physicians and health care providers to be aware of and to rely on.
